PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the program is to provide educational, cultural, and social training and experiences for a targeted group of youth to supplement and extend their educational opportunities beyond what they receive through their normal school curriculums.

PROGRAM CURRICULUM

➤ **Life Skills Education (Character Development):**

Students will engage in learning and developing the basic concepts (honesty, respect, goals, values, etc.) that are needed for successful living.

➤ **Financial Literacy Education:**

Students will learn financial skills and tools they can use throughout their lives. Some of the topics that will be covered are *Introduction to Taxes - Setting Financial Goals - Smart Shopping - Budgeting - Saving, and more...*

➤ **STEM Education: (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)**

Students will have the opportunity for STEM training and conducting hands-on STEM projects.

➤ **Career Exploration:**

Students will have the opportunity to study the requirements for various jobs and meet individuals with various professional and technical backgrounds. They will focus on the nature of various careers, the educational requirements, job responsibilities, the skill set needed to do the job successfully, and the career outlook.

➤ **Art Education:**

Students will have the opportunity to engage in studying the basics of the visual and performing arts, explore opportunities for art careers, and the impact of the arts on culture and society in general.

➤ **Recreation:**

The program will also provide students recreational opportunities _ e.g., soccer, golf, softball, volleyball, etc.

➤ **Industrial, Educational, and Cultural Field Trips:**

The Summer Enrichment Program will include field trips to industrial, educational, and cultural venues.
